

It is the result of cooperation between engineer Giulio Alfieri and the Touring coachbuilder, Built to compete with Ferrari's 250 GTs, the 3500 GT is the first Maserati resulting from series construction and industrial production of the Italian manufacturer.

Fascinating for her style that many consider a real success, whose "homogeneity" gives the car its unique charm, the **3500 GT** is the first major commercial success of the Italian firm. - work completed in December 2020 : brakes, gearbox and clutch.








