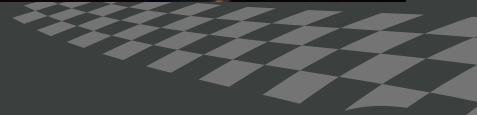

The **Maserati 3500 GT** is a grand touring automobile produced by the automaker Maserati from 1957 to 1964. It is the result of cooperation between engineer Giulio Alfieri and the Touring coachbuilder, Built to compete with **Ferrari's 250 GTs**, the **3500 GT** is the first **Maserati** resulting from series construction and industrial production of the Italian manufacturer.

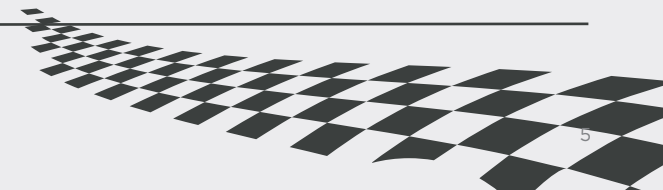

RESTORATION

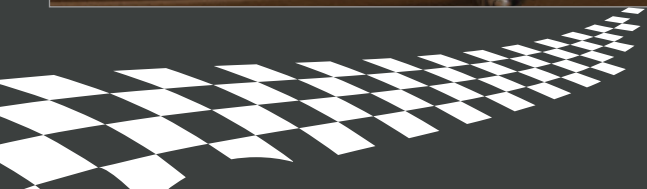
- Complete restoration conducted by Autoklassik in Germany.

- work completed in December 2020 : brakes, gearbox and clutch.





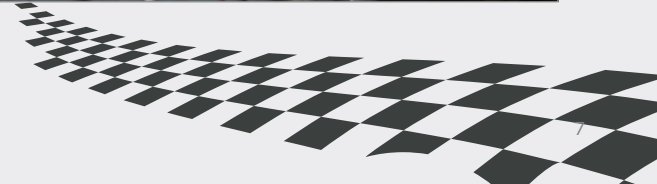

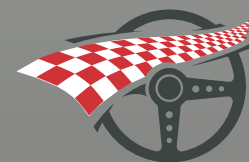
